

Legislative scorecard for the U.S. House during the 2024 calendar year

#### Liberty Index Overview

Created by the Republican Liberty Caucus, the 2024 Liberty Index is a liberty-focused legislative scorecard for the U.S. House. The Liberty Index scores Republican members of Congress on 20 pivotal bills/votes from 2024 that either advance liberty or diminish liberty. Green bills are pro-liberty bills supported by the RLC. Red bills are anti-liberty bills opposed by the RLC. For information on the bills we selected, see the bill explanations on pages three and four of this document.

A high score on this scorecard does not equate to an endorsement from the RLC. This scorecard simply evaluates the voting record of each Republican member of Congress during the 2024 calendar year.

#### Scoring Guide

A green number one indicates that the Representative voted with the RLC on that bill. A red number zero indicates the Representative voted against the RLC position on that bill. "NV" means the Representative was absent and did not vote. Representatives are scored on the votes they were present for. However, Representatives with more than three absences are penalized, starting with their fourth absence. "NA" means the Representative was not in office at that time. Representatives who were not in office the full year were only scored on votes during their tenure. "P" means the Representative voted Present. Voting Present is scored the same as an absence.

The Liberty Score is obtained by calculating the percentage that a Representative votes in line with the RLC. For example, the highest possible Liberty Score is 100. This is achieved if a Representative voted with the RLC 100% of the time. Bonus points are also available (see the list of bills).

About the Republican Liberty Caucus:





1 H.	R.2872	Oppose	This continuing resolution funds the federal government for another two months, through March 2024, at current spending levels. With \$36 trillion in debt, this fiscally irresponsible measure kicks the can down the road without any spending cuts. (Passed House 314-108 on 1/18/24, Passed Senate 77-18 on 1/18/24, Signed by President)
2 H.	R.7463	Oppose	The Extension of Continuing Appropriations and Other Matters Act. This continuing resolution funds the federal government from 3/8/24 to 3/22/24, at current spending levels. With \$36 trillion in debt, this fiscally irresponsible measure kicks the can down the road without any spending cuts. (Passed House 320-99 on 2/29/24, Passed Senate 77-13 on 2/29/24, Signed by President)
3 H.	Res.1061 / H.R. 4366	Oppose	The Consolidated Appropriations Act, which appropriates \$468 billion in new spending. This bill also funds about 30 percent of the federal government, including the Departments of Justice, Transportation, Energy, Agriculture, Commerce, Interior, Veterans Affairs, Housing and Urban Development, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the Food and Drug Administration. The bill also funds a massive new FBI building, along with an ATF pistol brace ban. This fiscally irresponsible omnibus bill enables big government to continue wasting taxpayer dollars while treading on our liberties.  (Passed House 339-85 on 3/6/24, Passed Senate 75-22 on 3/8/24, Signed by President)
4 H.	.R.7521	Oppose	The Protecting Americans from Foreign Adversary Controlled Applications Act. This bill gives the President authority to ban a social media company owned by a foreign adversary. This bill was designed to have the executive branch ban TikTok. This gives the President too much power, it violates free market principles and it infringes on our First Amendment right to freedom of speech. (Passed House 352-65 on 3/13/24, Held in Senate)
5 H.	.Res.1102 / H.R. 2882	Oppose	The Further Consolidated Appropriations Act. This \$1.2 trillion omnibus bill funds the following federal departments through FY24: Department of Education, Department of Defense, Department of Homeland Security, Department of Labor, Department of Health and Human Services, Department of State, and the Legislative Branch. With \$36 trillion in debt, this massive spending bill is fiscally irresponsible. (Passed House 286-134, Passed Senate 74-24, Signed by President)
	R.7888 Biggs mendment #1	Support	The Biggs Amendment #1 to H.R. 7888 would prohibit warrantless searches of U.S. person communications in the FISA 702 database (with exceptions for imminent threats to life or bodily harm, consent searches, or known cybersecurity threat signatures). (Failed House 212-212 on 4/12/24)
7 H.	.R.7888	Oppose	The Reforming Intelligence and Securing America Act, which extends the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act for another five years. This bill allows the federal government to continue to violate our 4th Amendment privacy rights by enabling warrantless surveillance under FISA. (Passed House 273-147 on 4/12/24, Passed Senate 60-34 on 4/20/24, Signed by President)
×	able Motion to econsider H.R.7888	Oppose	After H.R. 7888 was passed, Rep. Luna filed a motion to reconsider, which would have allowed the House to block the final passage of the bill. However, the motion to table the motion to reconsider prevented members of the House from having that opportunity to kill the FISA bill. ( <i>Passed House 259-128 on 4/15/24</i> )
9 H.	.Res.1160 / H.R. 815	Oppose	This measure allowed the House to combine four separate foreign aid bills, concurring with the Senate version of H.R. 815. The package appropriated a total of \$97 billion in foreign aid for Ukraine, Israel, and Indo-Pacific allies. This legislation also imposed sanctions on Iran and Russia, while banning TikTok. (Passed House 316-94 on 4/19/24, Passed Senate 79-18 on 4/23/24, Signed by President)
10 H.	R.8038	Oppose	The 21st Century Peace Through Strength Act. This bill would have imposed sanctions on Iran and Russia, needlessly inserting the United States into undeclared wars which do not involve the U.S. Additionally, the bill would ban TikTok by forcing the owners to sell, a violation of free market principles and free speech. (Passed House 360-58 on 4/20/24)
11 H.	.R.8035	Oppose	The Ukraine Security Supplemental Appropriations Act, which would appropriate an additional \$61 billion in foreign aid to Ukraine. With \$36 trillion in debt, it is fiscally irresponsible to send taxpayer dollars overseas for foreign aid. Also, by sending foreign aid, the bill needlessly inserts the United States into an undeclared war which does not involve the U.S. ( <i>Passed House 311-112 on 4/20/24</i> )
12 H.	R.8034	Oppose	The Israel Security Supplemental Appropriations Act, which would appropriate an additional \$26.3 billion in foreign aid to Israel. With \$36 trillion in debt, it is fiscally irresponsible to send taxpayer dollars overseas for foreign aid. (Passed House 366-58 on 4/20/24)

	Bill	RLC Position	Description
13	H.R.4824	Oppose	The Carbon Sequestration Collaboration Act, which expands the Department of Energy's carbon sequestration/storage program. This bill grows federal bureaucracy at the expense of the taxpayers, estimated to cost \$31 million over the next four years. With \$36 trillion in debt, this unnecessary spending increase is fiscally irresponsible. (Passed House 364-44 on 4/23/24)
14	H.R.6090	Oppose	The Anti-Semitism Awareness Act. This bill is a blatant violation of our First Amendment right to freedom of speech. It directs the federal government to adopt an overbroad definition of anti-semitism, which could allow individuals, businesses and colleges to be prosecuted for criticizing Israel's military operations. Regardless, of one's opinion on Israel, we should always defend Americans' inalienable, constituional right to free speech. (Passed House 320-91 on 5/1/24)
15	H.R.5403	Support	The CBDC Anti-Surveillance State Act, which would prohibit the Federal Reserve from issuing a central bank digital currency without congressional authorization. (Passed House 216-192 on 5/23/24, Held in Senate)
16	H.R.8958	Oppose	The NASA Reauthorization Act, which appropriates \$26 billion to continue funding NASA in FY25. With \$36 trillion in debt, this spending is fiscally irresponsible. To save taxpayer money, much of NASA's activities could be left up to the private sector. (Passed House 366-21 on 9/23/24)
17	H.R.9747	Oppose	The Continuing Appropriations and Extensions Act. This continuing resolution continues to fund the federal government at current spending levels for three months, through 12/20/24. With \$36 trillion in debt, this fiscally irresponsible measure kicks the can down the road without any spending cuts. (Passed House 341-82 on 9/25/24, Passed Senate 78-18 on 9/25/24, Signed by President)
18	H.R.5009	Oppose	The National Defense Authorization Act for FY25. This 1,800 page bill appropriates \$895 billion for the military budget, a \$9 billion increase. With \$36 trillion in debt, it is fiscally irresponsible to give this much taxpayer money to a department that has failed its audit seven years in a row. Among the waste in the NDAA is \$500 million for foriegn aid, while allowing taxpayer money to fund travel costs for federal employees to receive abortions. (Passed House 281-140 on 12/11/24, Passed Senate 85-14 on 12/18/24, Signed by President)
19	H.R.10515	Oppose	The second version of the American Relief Act. This 1,557 page bill funds the federal government for three months through 3/14/25. In short, it approves over \$1 trillion in spending, including a \$110 billion spending increase. Even worse, the bill would suspend the debt limit until 2027, giving Congress two full years to spend away taxpayer money with no restraints. This omnibus bill is fiscally irresponsible and reckless. (Failed House 174-235 on 12/19/24)
20	H.R.10545	Oppose	The third version of the American Relief Act. This continuing resolution funds the federal government for three months through 3/14/25. It approves over \$1 trillion in spending, including a \$110 billion spending increase. With \$36 trillion in debt, this bill is fiscally irresponsible. (Passed House 366-34 on 12/20/24, Passed Senate 85-11 on 12/21/24, Signed by President)
В	H.R. 8421	Support	The Federal Reserve Board Abolition Act, which would abolish the Federal Reserve. (This bill has not moved, but cosponsors were awared two bonus points)
