Legislative scorecard for the U.S. House during the 2023 calendar year

Liberty Index Overview

Created by the Republican Liberty Caucus, the 2023 Liberty Index is a liberty-focused legislative scorecard for the U.S. House. The Liberty Index scores Republican members of Congress on 20 pivotal bills/votes from 2023 that either advance liberty or diminish liberty. Green bills are pro-liberty bills supported by the RLC. Red bills are anti-liberty bills opposed by the RLC. For information on the bills we selected, see the bill explanations on pages three and four of this document.

A high score on this scorecard does not equate to an endorsement from the RLC. This scorecard simply evaluates the voting record of each Republican member of Congress during the 2023 calendar year.

Scoring Guide

A green number one indicates that the Representative voted with the RLC on that bill. A red number zero indicates the Representative voted against the RLC position on that bill. “NV” means the Representative was absent and did not vote. Representatives are scored on the votes they were present for. However, Representatives with more than three absences are penalized, starting with their fourth absence. “NA” means the Representative was not in office at that time. Representatives who were not in office the full year were only scored on votes during their tenure.

The Liberty Score is obtained by calculating the percentage that a Representative votes in line with the RLC. For example, the highest possible Liberty Score is 100. This is achieved if a Representative voted with the RLC 100% of the time. Bonus points are also available (see the list of bills).

About the Republican Liberty Caucus:

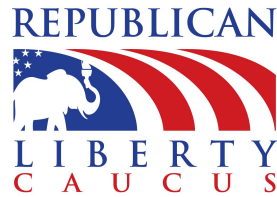

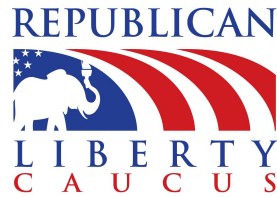

Bill	RLC Position	Description
H.J.Res.7	Support	This joint resolution terminates the national emergency concerning COVID-19 declared by the President on March 13, 2020. <i>(Passed House 229-197 on 2/1/23, Passed Senate 68-23 on 3/29/23, Signed by President)</i>
H.Con.Res.21	Support	This concurrent resolution directs the President to remove U.S. Armed Forces from Syria within 180 days. <i>(Failed House 103-321 on 3/8/23)</i>
H.R.5 Massie Amendment #15	Support	The Massie #15 amendment to H.R.5 would have terminated the Department of Education on 12/31/23. <i>(Failed House 161-265 on 3/23/23)</i>
H.R.1	Support	The Lower Energy Costs Act repeals numerous regulations and taxes on American energy production. The bill would expedite the permitting process for energy production on federal lands and waters, while also expediting hardrock mining, pipeline manufacturing, water infrastructure and natural gas. Overall, H.R.1 would make it easier and cheaper to produce American energy. <i>(Passed House 225-204 on 3/30/23, but failed to advance in the Senate)</i>
H.R.467	Oppose	The HALT Fentanyl Act expands the federal war on drugs by permanently placing fentanyl-related substances into Schedule I, while imposing a ten year mandatory minimum prison term for fentanyl-related offenses. The bill also expands federal bureaucracies by establishing a new registration process for Schedule I drug research. One-size-fits-all federal mandatory minimums are often redundant to state laws, forcing judges to issue excessive and duplicative sentences. Per the 10th Amendment, this issue should be left to the states. <i>(Passed House 289-133 on 5/25/23, but failed to advance in the Senate)</i>
H.J.Res.44	Support	This joint resolution would repeal the unconstitutional rule issued by the ATF that currently bans pistol braces. <i>(Passed House 219-210 on 6/13/23, Failed Senate 49-50 on 6/22/23)</i>
H.R.277	Support	The Reins Act of 2023 requires congressional approval before federal agencies issue any rule/regulation that will impact the economy. The REINS Act returns legislative authority to Congress, where it belongs. The Constitution grants legislative powers to Congress, not unelected bureaucrats. <i>(Passed House 221-210 on 6/14/23, but failed to advance in the Senate)</i>
H.R.1640	Support	The Save Our Gas Stoves Act places limits on the Department of Energy to prevent the federal government from restricting the people's freedom to use gas stoves. <i>(Passed House 249-181 on 6/14/23, but failed to advance in the Senate)</i>
H.R.2670 Jackson Amendment #5	Support	The Jackson #5 amendment to H.R.2670 prohibits the Secretary of Defense from paying for or reimbursing expenses relating to abortion services. <i>(Passed House 221-213 on 7/13/23)</i>
H.R.2670 Greene Amendment #21	Support	The Greene amendment #21 to H.R.2670 strikes \$300 million of foreign aid for Ukraine from the NDAA. <i>(Failed 89-341 on 7/13/23)</i>
H.R.2670 Greene Amendment #48	Support	The Greene amendment #48 to H.R.2670 prohibits the transfer of cluster munitions to other countries, including Ukraine. <i>(Failed House 146-276 on 7/13/23)</i>
H.R.2670 (first version)	Oppose	This was the House's first version of 2023 NDAA, which appropriates \$886 billion for military spending, a \$23 billion increase from the prior year. Adjusted for inflation, this would be the largest military budget since World War II. With a \$34 trillion national debt, this much spending is irresponsible. <i>(Passed House 219-210 on 7/14/23, but was drastically amended in the Senate before its final passage in December)</i>
H.R.4368 Hageman Amendment #83	Support	The Hageman amendment #83 to H.R.4368 would have prevented funds from being used to mandate electronic identification eartags for cattle and bison. <i>(Failed House 97-336)</i>
H.R.5860	Oppose	This continuing resolution approved 45 days of federal funding. It bypassed the formal budgeting process without any significant spending cuts, kicking the can down the road for another 45 days. <i>(Passed House 335-91 on 9/30/23, Passed Senate 88-9 on 9/30/23, Signed by President)</i>
Jim Jordan for House Speaker	Support	Jim Jordan's bid for House Speaker provided the best opportunity to obtain principled, liberty-focused leadership in the House. Jordan earned 200 votes on 10/17/23, falling just 17 votes shy of the majority needed to win.
H.R.4820 Massie Amendment #60	Support	The Massie Amendment #60 to H.R.4820 would repeal a portion of statute that currently requires all new vehicles manufactured after 2026 to have a kill switch used to monitor driver performance. <i>(Failed House 201-229 on 11/7/23)</i>

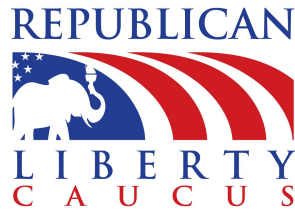

H.R.4664 Gaetz Amendment #54	Support	The Gaetz #54 amendment to H.R.4664 would strike the \$300 million currently allocated for a new FBI building. <i>(Failed House 145-273 on 11/8/23)</i>
H.R.4664 Rosendale Amendment #92	Support	The Rosendale amendment #92 to H.R.4664 would defund the Office of Gun Violence Prevention, a wasteful, unconstitutional program used by the President to restrict citizens' 2nd Amendment rights. <i>(Failed House 208-212 on 11/8/23)</i>
H.R.6363	Oppose	This continuing resolution approved another two and a half months of federal funding. It bypassed the formal budgeting process without any significant spending cuts, kicking the can down the road for another two and a half months. <i>(Passed House 336-95 on 11/14/23, Passed Senate 87-11 on 11/15/23, Signed by President)</i>
H.R.2670 (final version)	Oppose	The final version of the 2023 NDAA. This 3,000 page bill appropriated \$886 billion for military spending, a \$23 billion increase from the prior year. Adjusted for inflation, this is the largest military budget since World War II. With a \$34 trillion national debt, this much spending is irresponsible. The bill also extended the unconstitutional FISA program to 2025, which was inserted in conference committee, violating congressional rules. The bill also funds abortion services for military service members. <i>(Passed Senate 87-13 on 12/13/23, Passed House 310-118 on 12/14/23, Signed by President)</i>
Andy Biggs for House Speaker	Support	The Republican Liberty Caucus endorsed Andy Biggs when he ran for House Speaker. The ten members of Congress who voted for Biggs on the first ballot on 1/3/23 were each awarded two bonus points.

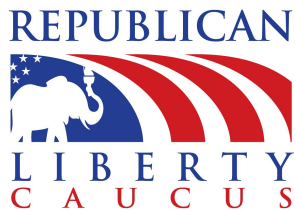

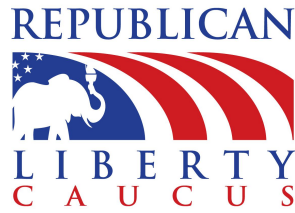

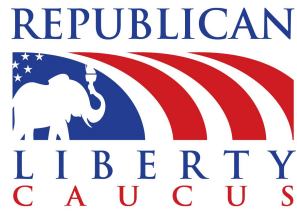
